Lockdown Brewing Company

Lockdown Brewing Co. is the "Home of the Folsom Prison Brews". The beers of Lockdown Brewing Co. are hand crafted with all natural ingredients without adjuncts such as cereal, rice or fillers. Lockdown Brewing Co. exhibits the rich history of Folsom and the Folsom Prison through its identity and labeling. Folsom was home to many firsts. It was the home to the first Railroad in the West and the first city to transport electricity over the wire over several miles, 22 to be exact. The prison is California's second oldest and has been made famous thru media like Johnny Cash's "Folsom Prison Blues" and the movie "Walk the Line".

Here's the Story and we're Sticking to it.

The love of craft ale started back in Chico, CA with cheap pitchers of pale ale during happy hour in one of Robert Whistler and Jim Gowan's favorite watering holes. Living in "Mecca" taught them to appreciate fine craft ales, and never thought of brewing it themselves.

It wasn't until Christmas of 1995 when the love of brewing craft beer came to fruition, a gift that started the home brew passion: a brew kit.

In early 1996 the first brew was a pale ale which turned out decent enough to drink, pretty good for a couple rookies. For the next year brewing became a monthly event. They mixed up the varieties and had an exceptionally good time giving gift baskets of home brew to friends and family. The more they brewed, the more they bottled. Brewing, bottling, brewing, bottling.....It was becoming apparent that the bottling was going to get old after a while, so they finally decided to invest in a full grain system.

About that time, one of the friend's dad was closing down a manufacturing plant and had to get rid of some excess angle iron. A rack was designed on paper and two months later it was built. The finishing touches were put on the rack and some draught equipment was installed on the garage fridge.

A few brews into it, they decided to come up with a name for their so-called "brewing company". Living in Old Town Folsom, there was much history to draw from. One night while brewing they heard a lockdown bell ring from the prison, Lockdown Brewing Company slid off of someone's tongue. Being Johnny Cash fans, they became the "Home of the Folsom Prison Brews".

Stony Bar Scotch Ale

A light Scottish-Style ale, named after the first dam site in Folsom, has a medium malty and fruity character with a hint of chocolate, caramel and roast. It is a full bodied ale that is well balanced with a soft, hoppy flavor that has a long warming finish.

Represa Red Ale

An American ESB (extra special bitter), complex, bold and toasty in flavor. The use of specialty grains gives this ale, named after the old prison city, a brilliant mahogany color. It is "dry hopped" for a heightened aromatic finish. Hop heads rejoice!

Emma's Blonde Ale

Named after a great Folsomite that ran a not-so-great business, this is a golden ale that is light in body. Small additions of hop makes this ale the perfect thirst quencher. Crisp & dry for a refreshing pint anytime.
